

Skilled Trades Foreman

Position Summary

As a Skilled Trades Foreman, you will be responsible for working and overseeing and managing skilled trade teams of up to ten (10) workers, activities as they relate to planning of labor force, materials, and methods of installation on assigned projects. This includes working with, communicating directions, supporting, evaluating, and leading corrective actions for all employees under his and/or her direction. The main objective of a Foreman position is to implement a culture of Accountability by maximizing jobsite safety, teamwork, quality, productivity, and customer loyalty.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

- Review project documents for required materials, material tack-offs per project specifications, submittals, installation requirements and identify conflicts that need clarification.
- Manage required tools, materials, and project work schedule.
- Manage project teams work time, JHA planning, work area environment and safety.
- Provide installation instructions, quality review of detailed sketches, lay-outs, and mentor project team.
- Delegating work team schedule and assignments, work area Assign project teams for scheduled project activity completion dates.
- Reinforce and manage safety and tool safety for project teams and total project safety.
- Review installation, existing systems for code or improper installations.
- Lead troubleshooting, diagnose reviews and repairs as needed.
- Dailey communication with project management, lead supervision, shop, and office
- Manage trades safe system test, leading any corrective actions and logging results.
- Manage and responsible for clocking in workers time and safety audit or reviews.
- Work with project team leaders on reviewing and maintaining as built drawing and project documents.
- Reinforce Safety, Safety Goals, job site hazard elimination and efficiently with DynaTen and all project team members.
- Reinforce and participate in training, safety training and mentoring and directing apprentices and other project team members.
- Maintain and Support project team with a safe and clean work environment, personal protection equipment (PPE), company tools, rentals, and personal hand tools.
- Attend assigned personal growth training classes and grow with additional volunteer training opportunities.
- Involved in determining workforce needs and the effective use of all department resources.
- Fulfills responsibilities in accordance with the organization's policies and processes.

- Software Navigation skills, Bluebeam, Pro Core, Microsoft Office, and other required electronic documentation.

Working Conditions
